- **(5) Presentation Description:** Highly effective teams can accomplish what would be difficult, or impossible, for one person acting alone. Imagine a single human being building the entire interstate highway system, or writing all of the books in your local library. Impossible!

We must often collaborate with others to accomplish goals that only a group of people can achieve. But a group is not the same as a team, and there are many barriers to fully unleashing "group genius". Even working with just one other person can be challenging, and the complexity of teamwork rises exponentially.

An MIT study of global team effectiveness found that only 18% of teams considered themselves successful. Learn to overcome the most frequent causes of failure cited:
